Title: Substitute Teacher

**Summary:** The Substitute Teacher provides academic instruction and socioemotional support to at-risk

youth, grades 7-12, in an alternative school setting. In an open, small classroom environment, the Teacher must demonstrate a high degree of flexibility in serving the individualized instructional needs of the students assigned to the class. Teacher should possess a high degree of authenticity, kindness, and empathy while effectively maintaining a

classroom atmosphere conducive to academic and socioemotional growth.

## Essential Functions & • Responsibilities: •

- Instructs students and facilitates their learning in the absence of the regular teacher
- Provides classroom instruction to students as outlined in lesson plans
- Creates a classroom that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of students
- Maintains a safe and orderly environment
- Maintains established routine of the school and classroom procedures in which assigned
- Takes all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities
- Maintains reasonable rules of conduct which encourage self-discipline and responsibility
- Meets and instructs assigned classes in the locations and times designated

Required Skills: •

- Ability to read, analyze, and interpret lesson plans, technical procedures, and textbooks
- Ability, both orally and in writing, to present information effectively and respond appropriately to questions and concerns from students, administrators, parents, etc.
